
Bleeding

1 Put on gloves.

2 Apply direct pressure.









2 Apply tourniquet high and tight on limb.



3 Tighten and secure tourniquet.



4 Write time applied on tag.

General Steps Check Victim Adult CPR **AED Use** Choking 1 Make sure the scene is safe. **Adult or Child** Infant Have someone call 9-1-1. When an AED is available turn Check responsiveness and breathing. on the device and follow Position your hands correctly Support head and neck 2 Check the victim. Provide chest compressions voice prompts. a. Tap and shout. just above the navel. and position face down. if unresponsive and not **b.** Look at chest and face. Give 5 back blows. 3 Call 9-1-1 if needed. breathing normally. 2 Place pads on bare, dry chest. **2** Give abdominal thrusts until a. Place 2 hands in center of chest. 2 Roll face up. Give 5 chest thrusts. the object is removed. 3 Analyze heart rhythm. 4 Provide care until help arrives. **b.** Compress fast and deep. c. DO NOT lean or bounce. 4 Deliver shock if indicated. **5** Provide 5 sets of CPR. 6 Repeat steps 3-5 until person responds or EMS takes over.
